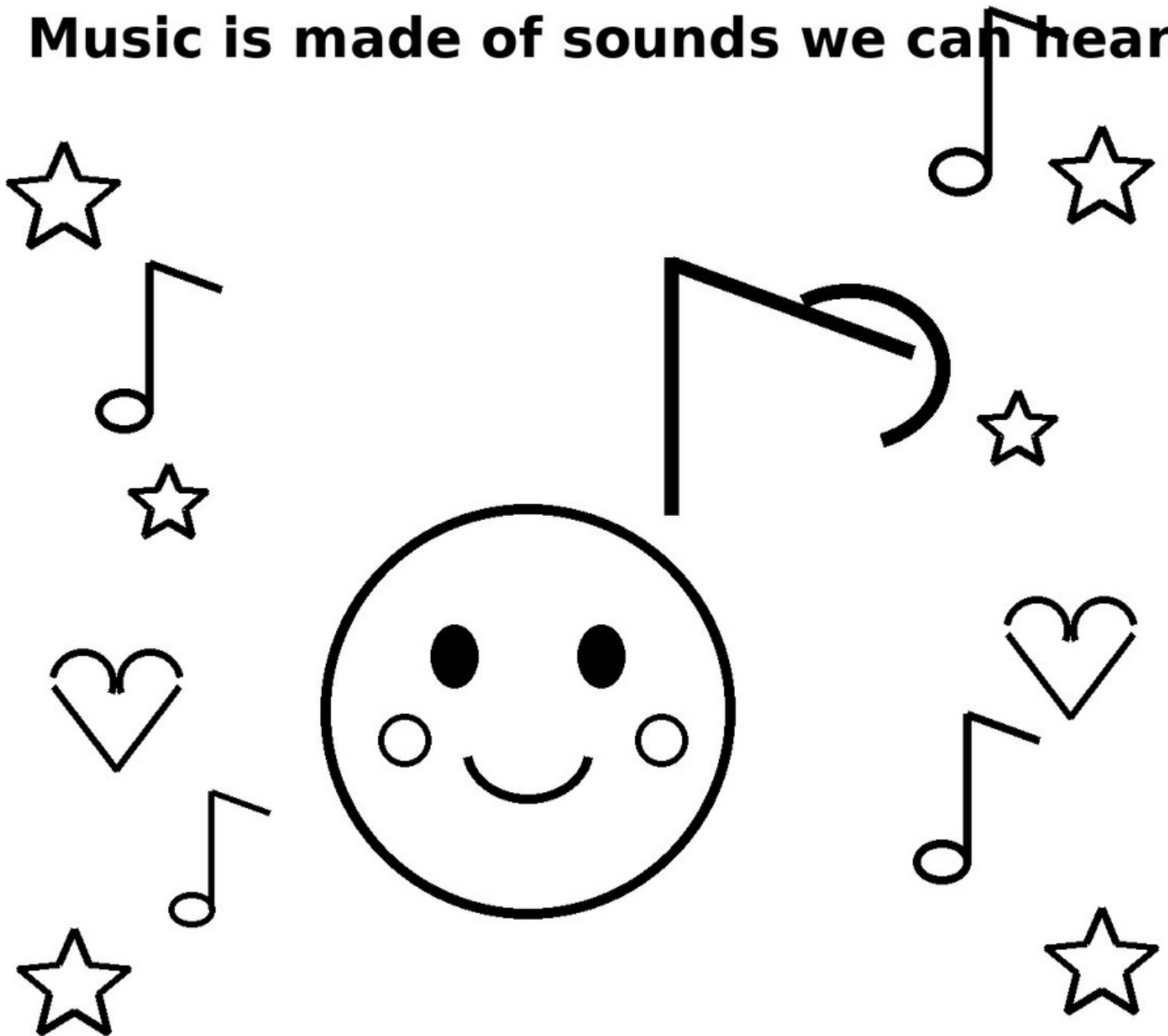

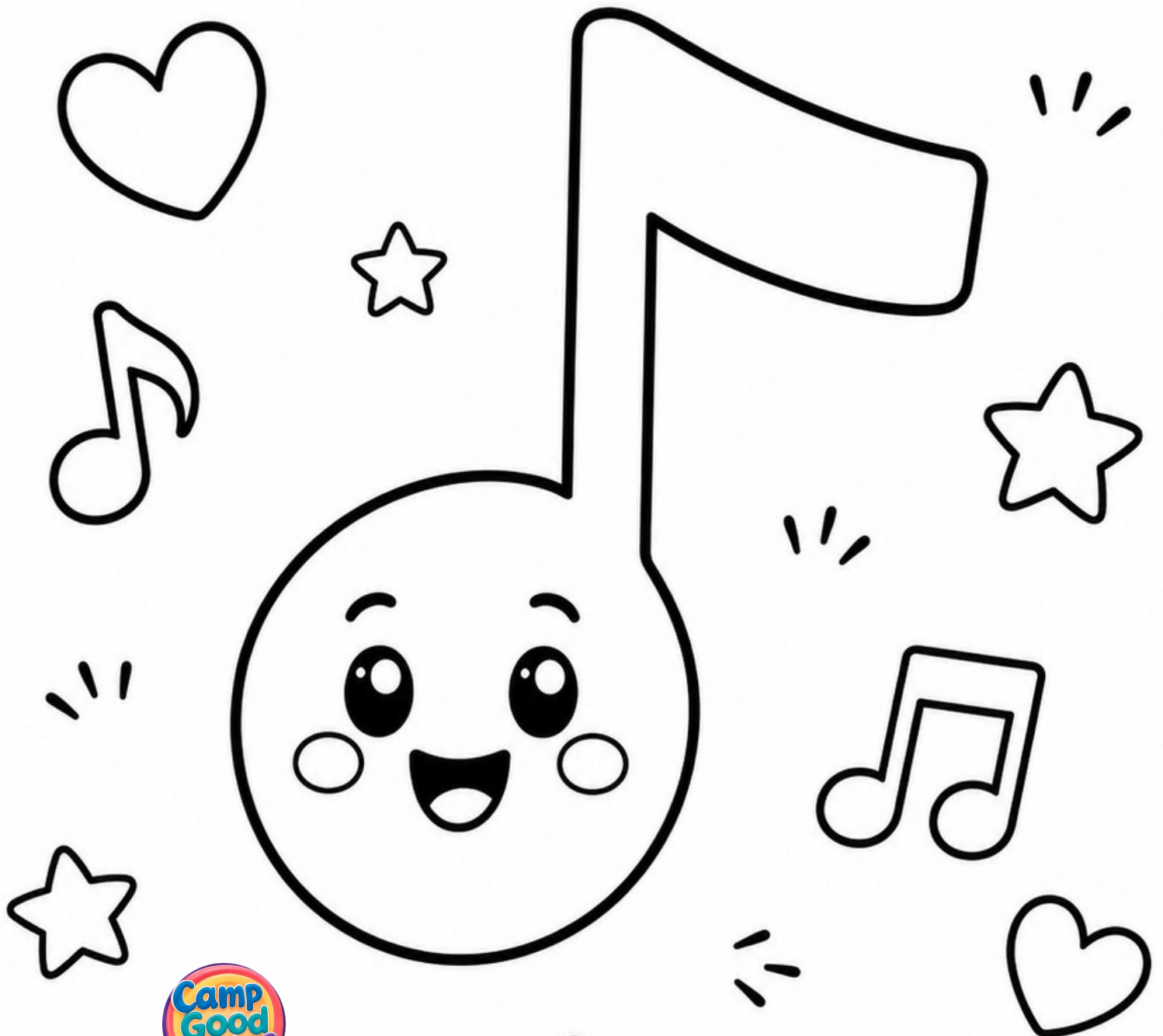
MUSIC

Music is made of sounds we can hear.



NOTE

A note is a sound in music.



BEAT

A beat is the steady pulse we can clap.



RHYTHM!

Rhythm is a pattern of sounds.



TEMPO

Tempo tells how fast or slow music goes.



LOUD

Loud means a big strong sound.



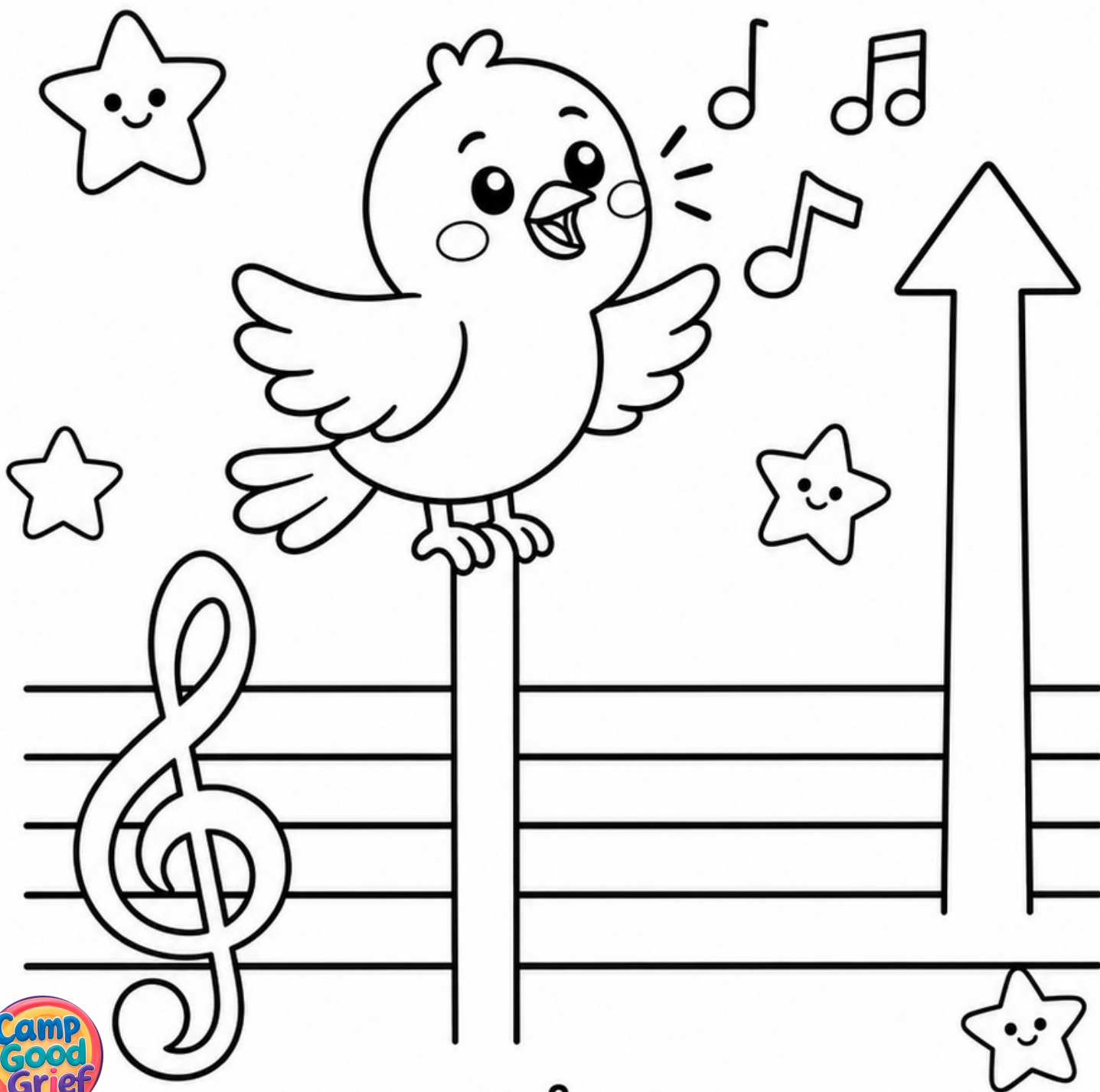
SOFT

Soft means a quiet gentle sound.



HIGH

High means a sound that goes up.



LOW

Low means a sound that goes down.



REST

A rest means be quiet for a moment.



MELODY

A melody is a tune we can sing.



STAFF

A staff is the lines where notes can sit.



TREBLE CLEF

A treble clef is a music sign on the staff.



PIANO

A piano is an instrument with keys.



DRUM

A drum is an instrument we tap and beat.



SING

To sing is to make music with your voice.



DANCE!

To dance is to move your body to music.



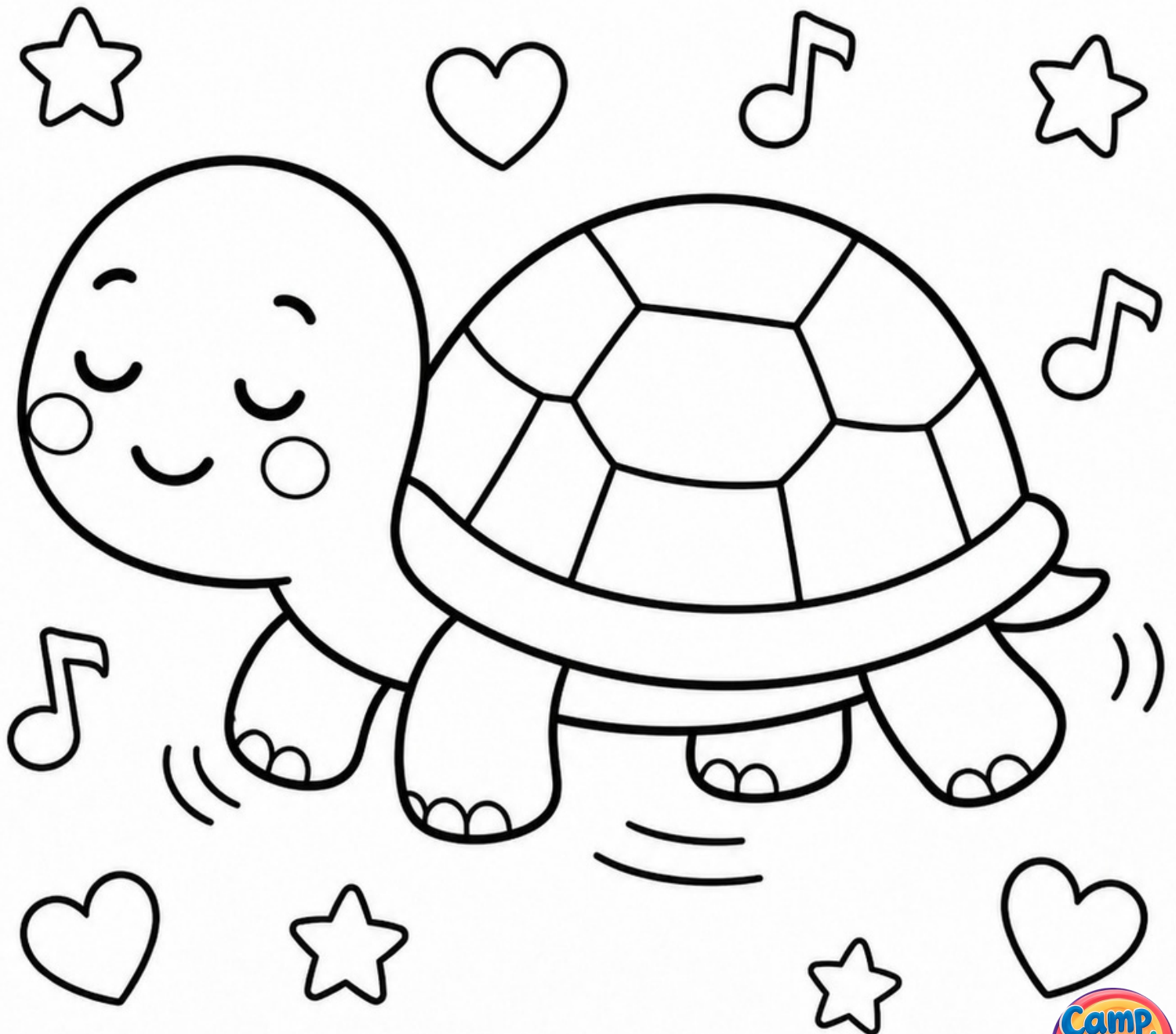
FAST
